### Unique Student Identifier (VET Students only)

From 1 January 2015 the Australian Government requires students undertaking nationally recognised training delivered by a registered training organisation to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). This includes studying at TAFE or with a private training organisation, completing an apprenticeship or skill set, certificate or diploma course. A USI gives you access to your online USI account which is made up of ten numbers and letters. It will look something like this: 3AW88YH9U5. A USI account will contain all your nationally recognised training records and results from 1 January 2015 onwards. Your results from 2015 will be available in your USI account in 2016. You must ensure all details entered to create your USI are accurate and match your RTO's information.

#### How to get a USI

It is free and easy for you to create your own USI online.

#### Steps to create your USI

The following steps show how you can create a USI:

Step 1 Have at least one and preferably two forms of ID ready from the list below:

Visa (with Non-Australian Passport) for international students	Birth Certificate (Australian)	
Certificate Of Registration By Descent	Citizenship Certificate	Immi Card

Step 2 Have your personal contact details ready (e.g. email address, or mobile number, or address).

Step 3 Visit the USI website at: [www.usi.gov.au](http://www.usi.gov.au)

Step 4 Select the 'Create a USI' link and follow the steps.

Step 5 Agree to the Terms and Conditions.

Step 6 Follow the instructions to create a USI – it should only take a few minutes. Upon completion, the USI will be displayed on the screen. It will also be sent to your preferred method of contact.
